Proceedings: On site, EAEEIE 2009 will deliver informal proceedings of the accepted contributions. During the closing session of the conference a special award will be presented to the best paper of EAEEIE 2009. After the conference the formal proceedings will be produced and made available via IEEE database IEEE Xplore.

Deadlines and Key Dates:

- Submission of manuscripts: January 23, 2009
- Notification of acceptance: March 27, 2009
- Camera-ready manuscript and early registration deadline: April 20, 2009
